RN Selective Entrance Criteria

Interested students usually begin in a pre-degree called Liberal Arts with a minor in Pre-Nursing. This helps students properly prepare for the registered nursing (RN) program. Nursing applications are reviewed for acceptance after each semester. The RN Escanaba program seats will be awarded no later than July, for a start date of the Fall Semester. The RN Iron Mountain program seats will be awarded no later than December 1, for a start date of the Winter Semester.

- **Meet prerequisites for BIOL 213 anatomy and physiology (or course completion with "C" or better)**
 - Meet reading (R) prerequisite
 - 1 year of high school biology or entry level college biology (with "C" or better)-Bay College equivalent is BIOL 104 [Prereq: E & R]

1 year of high school chemistry or entry level college chemistry (with "C" or better)-Bay College equivalent is CHEM 102/104 [Prereq: E, R, M]
