Why Surgical Technology?

In this program, a surge tech student is responsible for preparing the patient and the operating room for surgery and hands the instruments to the doctor and other members of the surgical team. The student's apprentices from the participating hospitals, will begin their five-semester, 62-credit hour program leading to an Associate of Applied Science in Surgical Technology. The graduates will then be ready to take the National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting national certification exam.

Why Bay College?

The [Surgical Technology program](#) at Bay College helps students develop a general knowledge of operating room skills needed to attain an entry level position as a Surgical Technologist. Students must complete 4,000 practicum hours and work a set number of cases in orthopedics, cardiovascular, neurovascular, urology, and OB/GYN.
